NEW HOMEWORK SCHEME

Your child should bring a pack home containing <u>a</u>

<u>Literacy and a Maths homework book.</u> The

routine is as follows:

- Homework will be set every <u>FRIDAY</u>. This will be a page each of Maths and English.
- It is very important that your child <u>only</u> <u>completes the pages set</u> and does <u>not</u> do any extra pages as these are for later on.
- Homework must be handed in on THURSDAY.
- As well as written homework, the children should be <u>reading</u> to an adult (younger children) or independently (older children) each day, <u>practising any spellings or phonics sounds</u> they may be given and <u>practising counting or times tables</u> as directed by the teacher, each day.

- Teachers also set activities to be completed at home on our <u>Education City website</u>.
- On <u>Thursdays</u> ALL of the children are expected to be thinking about, talking about and making notes (older children) for their BIG WRITING on Friday morning.
- If for any reason your child does not seem to have received their homework for the week or it has not been marked, please contact the teacher and / or the headteacher or deputy headteacher immediately so that the problem can be quickly sorted out.
