Nursery Admissions Policy

The Nursery operates two part time sessions per day:

Morning Nursery 8.30am – 11.30am. Afternoon Nursery 12.30pm – 3.30pm.

We also offer 30 hour funded places and the option for parents to pay for additional hours if there are places available.

Admission Procedure to the Nursery

Application forms can be obtained from the School Office.

N.B: Admission to the Nursery does not guarantee a place in Reception class.

Admissions to Nursery are allocated in the following way. A child will be admitted to Nursery the term after their third birthday using the following criteria (when spaces are available).

- 1. Baptised Catholic children who are looked after or previously looked after.
- 2. Baptised Catholic children living in the parish of Our Blessed Lady and St Thomas of Canterbury, Dudley who have a brother or sister attending St Joseph's Catholic Primary School, Dudley at the time of admission.
- 3. Baptised Catholic children living in the parish of Our Blessed lady and St Thomas of Canterbury, Dudley
- 4. Other Baptised Catholic children who have a brother or sister attending St Joseph's Catholic Primary School at the time of admission.

- 5. Baptised Catholic children living in the parish of Sacred Heart and the Holy Souls, Tipton.
- 6. Other Baptised Catholic children.
- 7. Non-Catholic children who are looked after or previously looked after.
- 8. Non-Catholic children who have a brother or sister attending St Joseph's Catholic Primary School at the time of admission.
- 9. Non-Catholic children.

Applications are available from school and must be returned as soon as possible.

There are no appeals for Nursery places. Applicants will be judged accordingly to the criteria.

If the Nursery is full at the time of application, a waiting list is kept. Places on the waiting list are ranked according to the admission criteria 1-9. As places become available they are allocated to the child ranked highest on the waiting list at the time.
